Community Events Posting Policy
Approved by the Board of Trustees 4/9/2019
Approved 9.13.2022

The Nampa Public Library has two Community Events displays on the second and third floors, as well as a standing display in the lobby.

The Library encourages the display of informational materials from government, non-profit, community and educational institutions; as well as information promoting events of cultural and general interest to the local community.

- Items posted will not exceed 18" x 24" in size.
- Postings will be kept for 30 days or until event date has passed.
- Items removed from the Bulletin Board or counter will be discarded.
 - The library does not take responsibility for returning items to owners.
- Items should not cover previously posted notices.

What is not permitted:

- Postings containing content that could be considered discriminatory or harassing based on a group or individual's protected status (i.e., race, color, religion/religious creed, sex/gender, pregnancy, marital status, age, national origin/ancestry, physical and/or mental disability, medical condition, sexual orientation, gender identity, military or veteran status, or status in any other group protected by federal, state or local law) or which advocates in any way for such discrimination.
- Offensive materials (as defined in Idaho State Code 18-4105 or 18-1514), materials promoting illegal activities, or inappropriate materials.
- Postings that support or oppose any current or pending ballot measure or political candidate.
- Postings advertising the selling of goods or products.
